The drum and dance classes will be lead by Sibou, Lucky & Yacou when in their own country and backed by a team of the best local talent of musicians, dancers & choreographers, The DRUM CLASS will challenge students with traditional rhythmic patterns, technique development & building strength and stamina. The DANCE CLASS will inspire students to free their bodies to learn traditional choreographies & lift their energy to soar to new heights.

The easiest way to travel to West Africa is with flights into Paris, Brussels or London or with Emirates through to Dubai. Your flights will cost around \$3300 when you book early. We will provide you with booking information for your flights within Africa. Let us know if you would like us to refer you to a Travel Agent. We will organise your visas for students travelling from Australia.

Please be advised that there are diseases such as Yellow Fever and Malaria in West Africa and students considering travelling will need to consult a health professional regarding vaccinations that are compulsory and/or recommended. Please do so well before the date of travel. All students are expected to travel with travel insurance.

Please note - . All information and fees relating to Visas must be supplied by 15th November 2016.

Accommodation will be comfortable, secure premises in each country. The course will also include refreshing visits to *islands and villages in each country*. Traditional meals will be prepared by the local women. Meals typically consist of rice and fish or meat with vegetables and fresh fruit.
